Homalco First Nation has recently purchased the (RTS) Referral Tracking System thru DR Systems Inc.

I have found the program to be both, user friendly and very efficient. Homalco First Nation receives a large number of referrals weekly, the RTS program has enabled me to organize the information, set priorities, track costs and work progress.

Although I am not currently using the full capacity of the database as we are at the beginning stages of structuring a Lands and Resources Department the RTS program has already proven to be worth the investment, I have been utilizing the invoice portion of the tracking system and to date I have already recovered the purchase price for the system.

For Homalco First Nation this invoicing portion of the tracking system is a vital part of the program as before purchase of this program Homalco was going into deficit dealing with the referrals as this is an unfunded department.

The locator forms allow for efficient reporting on a variety of areas including proponent activities, staff progress and cost analysis.

I anticipate being able to add our Traditional Knowledge to the program, this will enable Homalco to identify areas of priority for protection, traditional use, land use planning and use analysis throughout our Traditional Territory.
